PEGI Ratings

Our school, Chilthorne Domer Church School, is committed to keeping children safe online.

In our recent online safety survey, we found out that a few of the children didn't know what the PEGI ratings were. Do you know what they are?

It is quite normal for children not to understand what the PEGI ratings are and therefore we have chosen to teach you and your children what they are so that you can stay safe online.

PEGI ratings are ratings to keep people safe online. They are age ratings to show you which games and apps are appropriate for your age to go on and use.

There are three colours: green, orange and red. Green is ages three and seven. Orange is ages twelve and sixteen. Red is age eighteen.



Some children and adults may choose a game or app that is not appropriate for their age. This is why we need to understand the PEGI ratings. They will help to keep you safe.
