- 1. Election Of Chairman (unless the Parish Council Chairman is present to take the chair) As Mr Woodman was not present Mr Batstone offered to chair the meeting, this was agreed unanimously.
- 2. Apologies for Absence Apologies were received from Mr Woodman.
- 3. Minutes of the Previous Meeting the minutes of the previous meeting had been agreed as a true and accurate record at the Parish Council meeting held in June 2022.

Special thanks to Tim for downloading the information, and moving it to different locations as needed. The CID has shown up speeds of over 100mph on the A37 and the unclassified road between Yeovil and Tintinhull.

PLANNING

We have had a few planning applications over the last 12-months. We are still waiting for the start of the 28-houses behind the Carpenters Arms.

RECREATIONAL GROUND

The Parish Council gave a grant for the toddler play equipment. The solar panel project is still producing electricity for the .recreational club. Thanks to Tim for monitoring.

NEW MEMBERS

We welcomed a new member Mrs R Parsons.

INTERNET

12-months on we are still waiting for Wessex Internet to supply full fibre to the village.
